In preparation, the squad will be training between 3:15pm and 4:15pm at Rushcutters Bay on Monday afternoons (for the track events) and Wednesday afternoons from 4:00pm to 5:00pm at E S Marks Field at Kensington (for both Track and Field events). The bus will leave Victoria St on Wednesdays at 3.15pm and return at 5.30pm or students can be collected from E.S Marks at 5.00pm. Transport - Please indicate transport requirements on the attached permission note. As outlined above, students will travel to E.S Marks via bus after school on the Friday Twilight meetings. Parents/Carers can pick their daughter up from E. S Marks once they have finished their events, or back at the College (approximate arrival time listed above).
